COUGARS STAY PERFECT!

The **Cougars** knew they could run the ball against the Crook County defense Friday night in Prineville. After all, they had the state's second leading rusher in **Ash Gibson**, and an offensive line that was dominate.

But little did **Mountain View** and **Gibson** know that they would need only a half of football to erase any doubts.

Leading 7-0 early in the second quarter following a 29 yard touchdown pass from **Scott Plants** to **Pat Cashman**, the **Mountain View** offense AND defense stepped up.

The **Cougars** began a drive, which included another long pass from **Plants** to **Cashman** on a 3rd and 12 to the Cowboy 1 yard line. **Gibson** would punch it in on the next play to put **Mountain View** up 14-0.

When Crook County got the ball back, senior defensive back **Ryan Shotwell** intercepted a pass by the Cowboys quarterback and returned the ball 9 yards into the end zone for a 21-0 **Cougar** lead.

Mountain View would score twice more in the second quarter, once on a 1 yard run by fullback **Mike Warsaw**, and the other on a beautiful 31 yard run by **Ash Gibson** for a 36-0 lead at the half.

Gibson and most of the first team would give way to the second team **Cougars** in the third quarter. But that didn't stop **Mountain View**. The defense once again shutdown their opponent, on their way to their first shutout of the season.

Meanwhile, junior running back **Scott McCreery** added 95 yards rushing and a touchdown, while sophomore **Solomon Helms** ran for 70 yards on only 6 carries!

Kicker **Brian Cashman** closed out the scoring with a 26 yard filed goal for the final 46-0 dismantling of Crook County.








With the win, the **Cougars** moved to 2-0 in league play and 5-0 overall.

Mountain View's next game is Friday night (10/5) at home against The Dalles-Wahtonka.
