THE COUGARS PREVAIL 42-20!

Coming off a big win last week against 3rd ranked Wilsonville, and finding out on Tuesday (9/11) that they had moved up to their highest ranking in school history (#3), **Mountain View** was poised for a lop-sided win against Eagle Point.

And given the fact that the Eagles had lost to a 4A high school just the week before, on paper, a rout seemed a foregone conclusion. But as the sun was setting in Southern Oregon on Friday night (9/14), the Eagles were rising. Eagle Point took the opening kickoff and came out strong.

With a game plan designed to throw off the **Cougar** defense, throw they did. Quarterback Scott Erickson completed pass after pass, sprinkled with some running plays in-between, and cutting through the usually tough **Cougar** defense for a 20-14 lead at half time.

It wasn't like the **Mountain View** offense had played poorly up to that point. In fact the Eagles were having trouble stopping **Cougar** running back **Ash Gibson**, as he rushed for over a 100 yards and two touchdowns in the first half.

But as the **Mountain View** players entered the locker room to prepare for the second half, they were angry!

Coming out of the locker room, it was evident from the very first play that this wasn't the same **Cougar** team from 20 minutes earlier.

Mountain View took the second half kickoff and marched right down the field. Led by the running of **Gibson**, and timely passes from quarterback **Scott Plants**, they finished off the drive as **Gibson** ran it in from 10 yards out to tie the score at 20.

Kicker **Justin Hatch's** extra point gave the **Cougars** their first lead at 21-20, a lead that they would not relinquish.

As the **Mountain View** defense took the field, just as they had done against McKay and Wilsonville in the previous two weeks, the **Cougars** shut their opponent down and out in the second half.










Add to that another monster performance by **Gibson**, who rushed for 281 yards and tied a **Cougar** record with 5 touchdowns, including a spectacular 60 yard run, **Mountain View** dominated the rest of the game, scoring 28 unanswered points for a 42-20 win.

The **Cougars** moved to 3-0 with the win, and will open up league play Friday night (9/21) at home against Pendleton.

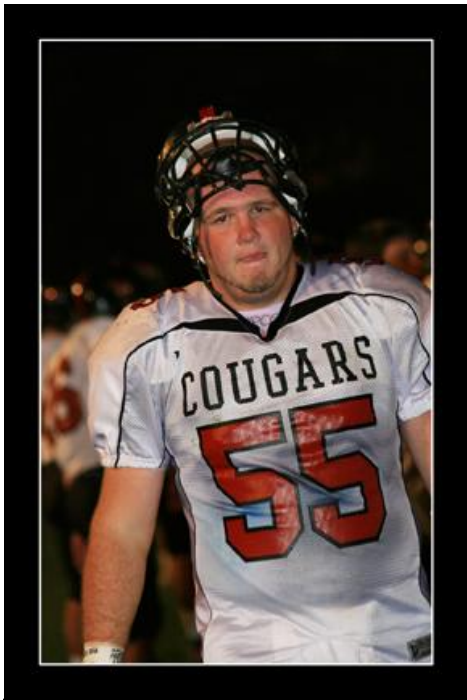
