

Mountain View Moves to 6-0!

COUGARS REMAIN UNBEATEN!

On a cold night at Jack Harris Stadium in Bend, the **Mountain View** defense was once again up to challenge.

The **Cougars** held the Eagle-Indians to under 200 yards of total offense and forced 8 turnovers to beat The Dalles-Wahtonka 35-7.

Mountain View dominated from the beginning with a stifling defense which forced 5 first half turnovers and held the Eagle-Indians to only 3 first downs.

On offense, the **Cougars** mixed it up with passes and runs, including a 30 yard bolt up the middle by running back **Ash Gibson** down to the Eagle-Indians 12 yard line on **Mountain View's** second possession (**Gibson** by the way also had a run of 33 yards called back by a holding penalty on that same drive).

Two plays later, wide receiver **Pat Cashman** took a pass by quarterback **Scott Plants** at the 2 yard line and carried the defender into the end zone for a 7-0 **Cougar** lead.

On **Mountain View's** next possession, the **Cougars** would drive all the way inside the Eagle-Indians 10 yard line only to turn it over on downs.

But **Mountain View** would strike again in the second quarter by chewing up big chunks of yardage by **Gibson** and backup tailback **Scott McCreery** down to The Dalles-Wahtonka 1 yard line. On the next play, fullback **Mike Warsaw** would dive across the goal line for a 14-0 lead.

On the Eagle-Indians next possession, **Cougar** linebacker **Matt Sturza** flew around the right side of the line, and sacked the Eagle-Indians quarterback, causing a fumble. **Mike Warsaw** recovered the ball at the 40 yard line with 2 ½ minutes to play in the half.

Mountain View would then drive toward the goal line, culminating in a spectacular 16 yard touchdown pass from quarterback **Scott Plants** to wide receiver **Josh Young** pushing **Mountain View's** lead to 21-0 at the half.

The second half began with The Dalles-Wahtonka trying an onside kick. All-State center **Hayden Mace** collected the kick at the 43 yard line and **Mountain View** was in business again.

It took less than 2 minutes for the **Cougars** to make the Eagle-Indians pay for their mistake. Following a terrific 29 run by **Mike Warsaw** to the 6 yard line, tailback **Ash Gibson** ran around the left side into the end zone to increase **Mountain View's** lead to 28-0.

The Eagle-Indians would finally score a touchdown midway through the third quarter as their own running back fumbled the ball into the end zone. Wide receiver Mark Sandoz recovered the fumble for The Dalles-Wahtonka to cut the deficit to 28-7.

The **Cougars** would add a late touchdown with just under 2 minutes left in the game on a 11 yard run by tailback **Scott McCreery** for the final 35-7 score.

Despite 5 turnovers and 10 penalties by the **Cougars**, they survived, moving their record to 3-0 in the IMC, and 6-0 overall.

Gibson, the state's second leading rusher entering the game, led the way with 220 yards on 25 carries, pushing his season total to over 1,100 yards.

Mountain View's next game is Friday October 12 at home against Summit.
