Bend, OR (10/02/09) – Through three quarters it looked like **Mountain View** might just beat Bend for a fourth straight year, but the Lava Bears scored 14 unanswered points in the fourth quarter to pull out a 28-21 win in the 2009 Civil War game.

Both **Mountain View** and Bend lost their star players in the second quarter, the Lava Bears All-IMC running back **Kyle Brown** was held out of the second half with a possible concussion, while the **Cougars** senior quarterback **Zach Johnson** went out in the second quarter with a broken collar bone.

It was a hard fought game, as all Civil war games are as Bend won the 31st meeting between the schools to break a 15-15 all tie, and now lead the all-time series 16-15.

Mountain View is now 1-1 in league play, and 3-1 overall and will be back at home Friday night against Summit in another IMC contest.
