Jags close season with a loss in Bend

BEND — Century's 2009 season came to a close Friday night with a 38-14 non-league loss at Mountain View.

The Jaguars, who made the playoffs last fall for the second time in school history, lost their final four games this time around to finish with a 3-7 overall record, including a 1-5 mark in the NWOC (tie-sixth).

After falling behind early against the host Cougars (8-1), Century came back to tie it when senior George Eberly recovered a fumble in the end zone. Brennen Scott's ensuing extra point made it 7-7 with 1:53 left in the opening quarter.

But then Mountain View poured in 31 straight points during the second and third quarters to pull away for the victory.

The Jaguars' final touchdown of the year took place in the fourth quarter. On the play, sophomore quarterback Dominic Akina connected with RJ Blosl for a 54-yard touchdown pass with 7:01 showing on the clock.
