COUGARS WIN 3RD STRAIGHT CIVIL WAR!

2008 CIVIL WAR GOES TO THE COUGARS!

Coming off a disastrous 45-6 shellacking at the hands of Hermiston the previous week, the Bend Lava Bears were out for redemption. The Lava Bears came into Central Oregon's 2008 Civil War matchup with **Mountain View** with a 1-3 record, but with a determination to beat their long-time rival.

The **Cougars** on the other hand, were coming off their most successful season in school history, going 11-1 and losing to eventual state champion West Albany in the 2007 Oregon 5A state semifinal. And this 2008 **Mountain View** team came into the Bend game with a 3-0 record, and a [#4](#) state ranking.

Bend would get the ball first but was forced to punt, as was **Mountain View** after a quick 3 and out on their first possession. But when Bend got the ball back, **Cougar** safety [Pat Cashman](#) stepped in front of a pass by Lava Bear quarterback **Chase Clair**, and returned it 52 yards to the Bend 15 yard line. 3 plays later, **Mountain View** quarterback [Scott Plants](#) would hand off to tailback [Scott McCreery](#) who ran around the left side and into the end zone, and the **Cougars** led 7-0.

On Bend's next possession, they would put together beautiful drive, helped out by the running of tailback Kyle Brown – driving all the way to the **Cougar** 2 yard line. But after an illegal procedure penalty, Lava Bears QB **Chase Clair** fumbled, and **Mountain View** defensive end [Tye Abbey](#) fell on the ball to turn away a sure Bend score.

Mountain View was unable to do anything with the ball however, and was forced to punt. The Lava Bears got the ball back in great field position, at the **Cougar** 35 yard line and drove inside the **Mountain View** 10 yard line.

On 3rd and goal from the 9 yard line, Lava Bear quarterback **Chase Clair** would throw the ball toward his receiver **Zane Cable** but **Cougar** defensive back **Scott McCreery** tipped the ball. However, the tipped pass fell into the hands of Bend's **Zane Cable** who caught it for the touchdown, and Bend was back in business with 11:21 in the second quarter.

Bend and **Mountain View** would trade possessions, and when the **Cougars** got the ball back at their own 45 yard line, they would begin a drive with quarterback [Matt Robertson](#) under center. During the drive on a 3 and 9, **Robertson** found wide out [Jesse Zapata](#) for a 15 yard gain to the Lava Bear 29 yard line and a crucial first down. Three plays later, **Robertson** found his tight end [Robert Turner](#) who was wide open in the end zone, and the **Cougars** had regained the lead 14-7.







With just over 3 minutes remaining in the half, Bend would again put together another excellent drive, culminating at the **Mountain View** 3 yard line with just over a minute in the half. But on 3rd and goal, **Cougar** linebacker [Chris Barber](#) picked off the pass of **Chase Clair** at the goal line, and returned it to the 30 yard line. **Mountain View** would run out the clock and go into halftime with a 14-7 lead.

Even though the **Cougars** led on the scoreboard, the Lava Bears had outgained **Mountain View** by almost 100 yards in the first half, and had 2 chances to score inside the **Cougar** 5 yard line, but had turned the ball over 3 times. It was clear that **Mountain View** would have to change up some things in the second half.

On Bend's first possession of the second half, **Pat Cashman** intercepted his second pass of the night, and **Mountain View** had the ball back at their own 42 yard line. But the **Cougars** could do nothing were forced to punt. On the punt, **Mountain View** quarterback and punter **Scott Plants** lined up to punt, along with the **Cougars** other quarterback **Matt Robertson** who lined up in the up position. The snap would go to **Robertson** on a fake punt, who then found a wide open **Pat Cashman** for 14 yards and a first down in Lava Bear territory.

MOUNTAIN VIEW vs. BEND

The **Mountain View** drive however, would stall at the Bend 19 yard line, and with the **Cougars** facing another 4th down, **Mountain View** decided to go for it again. This time, quarterback **Scott Plants** found **Pat Cashman** who then weaved through the Lava Bear defense and into the end zone for another **Cougar** touchdown. **Skylar Laughlin** kicked the extra point, and **Mountain View** now led 21-7 with 2:48 left in the third quarter.

The **Mountain View** defense had been stellar all night (as they have been all year), and after forcing another Lava Bear punt, the **Cougars** took over at their own 45 yard line. A few plays later, quarterback **Scott Plants** found a wide open **Jake Parades** for a 33 yard touchdown, but the officials called **Mountain View** for an illegal formation, and the touchdown was nullified.

The **Cougars** continued the drive however, and **Plants** and **McCreery** would push **Mountain View** inside the Bend 10 yard line. On a 3rd and goal from the 7, **Plants** dropped back to pass but a Bend defender hit **Plants** late and was called for a personal foul giving the **Cougars** a first and goal from the Lava Bears 3 yard line. 3 plays later, **Matt Robertson** would come in for **Plants** and would score on a quarterback keeper from 2 yards out and suddenly, **Mountain View** had an insurmountable 27-7 lead half-way through the 4th quarter.

Bend could not get much going the rest of the way, and Lava Bears QB **Chase Clair** was again picked off by **Pat Cashman** (his 3rd interception and the 5th turnover forced by the **Cougars**). Bu on **Mountain View's** next 3 possessions, they would fumble 3 times in just 5 plays, including 1 fumble that was brought back to the **Mountain View** 1 yard line with just over 2 minutes left in the game. Bend running back **Gage Henrich** fell across the goal line for the final score of the game, making it 27-14. With the win, **Fourth Ranked Mountain View** moved to 4-0 on the season, and beat Bend for the 3rd consecutive year. The **Cougars** next opponent is Summit on their brand new "Field Turf" stadium next Friday night (10/3).
